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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ If you are not feeling well, please worship virtually. (Common symptoms of COVID-19: typical cold/allergy symptoms, runny nose, scratchy throat, cough, headache, fatigue, upset/unsettled stomach). Please worship virtually if you have knowingly been exposed or have tested positive for COVID-19, as consistent with CDC guidelines.■ Upon entering the church, please wear a mask to cover your nose and mouth, sanitize hands, social distance, refrain from hugging and shaking hands. Fellowship after church in the open air.■ Be sure to review and answer the questions at the Welcome Center and Sign-In before entering the sanctuary.■ If you test positive for COVID-19 within 5 days of being in service, at meetings or activities sponsored by the church please notify the church office as soon as possible by calling 804-288-3224. Let us know what church sponsored activity you attended, when you tested positive, and with whom you had close contact. Your personal information will be confidential. You will receive a follow up call from our Safety Team.■ Be aware that vaccines and boosters are our best method of protection from severe disease and hospitalization.■ Continue to pray for each other throughout the Pandemic and extend grace and abundant love. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ The Safety Team commits to staying abreast of COVID-19 information and adapting protocols to ensure the safest environment possible during an ever-changing pandemic.■ The church will be disinfected and sanitized per CDC guidelines.■ The Safety Team will ensure that air purifiers are optimally placed and on at appropriate times.■ Upon notification of a COVID-19 Positive case, the church office will notify a representative of the Safety Team as soon as a COVID-19 Positive notification is received.■ The Safety Team will review the information and determine, based on CDC guidelines, if the potential exposure placed disciples at risk.■ If the exposure meets CDC timeframes for possible transmission, the Safety Team will notify those potentially impacted via email or by phone.■ A list of CDC and local health department resources will be provided to those potentially exposed.■ The Safety Team will continue to pray for our Church Family and extend grace and abundant love throughout this process.■ The Safety Team is comprised of Dr. Frances Dunston, Rev. Jeanette Brown, Representatives from the Health Ministry, Welcome Ministry and Trustee Ministry. |
